Ho’oponopono gives us the clear way to make this happen with the flor-de-lis symbol standing to bring awareness and elevate consciousness, as well as remind us to let go & let Divinity.”

As a distinguished authority on Ho’oponopono and Zero Frequency®, Katz will be presenting a message of peace is possible that stems from the theology that life consists of replayed memories and inherited pain that leads us to suffering. When we take 100% responsibility and release the past, rather than holding on to old memories, we create a blank slate so that love and inspiration may guide us.

Katz message strongly implies that our minds play the worst wars. Teaching others to know they are not those memories and to retain from this kind of thinking regardless of what is happening around us.
